Their efforts raised in excess of £70,000 for the charity, which in turn has enabled us to reach more organisations helping patients by launching the Charity Project Awards.

A panel of judges will make the final decision based on the completed application form. Please note we may take references as part of the application process. The Mouth Cancer Foundation Charity Project Awards are not linked in any way to any other grants or programmes run by the Mouth Cancer Foundation.
